Wise words on pride from Proverbs

8:13 To fear the LORD is to hate evil; I [wisdom] hate pride and arrogance, evil behaviour and perverse speech.

11:2 When pride comes, then comes disgrace, but with humility comes wisdom.

11:12 Whoever derides their neighbour has no sense, but the one who has understanding holds their tongue.

13:10 Pride only breeds quarrels, but wisdom is found in those who take advice.

15:25 The LORD tears down the house of the proud, but he sets the widow's boundary stones in place.

15:33 The fear of the LORD teaches a person wisdom, and humility comes before honour.

16:5 The LORD detests all the proud of heart. Be sure of this: they will not go unpunished.

16:18 Pride goes before destruction, a haughty spirit before a fall.

16:19 Better to be lowly in spirit and among the oppressed than to share plunder with the proud.

18:12 Before a downfall the heart is proud, but humility comes before honour.

21:4 Haughty eyes and a proud heart, the lamp of the wicked, are sin!

21:24 The proud and arrogant person – "Mocker" is his name; behaves with insolent fury.

22:4 Humility is the fear of the LORD; its wages are riches and honour and life.

27:2 Let another person praise you, and not your own mouth; someone else, and not your own lips.

27:21 The crucible for silver and the furnace for gold, but people are tested by the praise they receive.

29:1 Whoever remains stiff-necked after many rebukes will suddenly be destroyed - without remedy.

29:23 A person's pride brings them low, but the lowly in spirit gain honour.

30:11-14&17 There are those who curse their fathers and do not bless their mothers; **12** those who are pure in their own eyes and yet are not cleansed of their filth; **13** those whose eyes are ever so haughty, whose glances are so disdainful; **14** those whose teeth are swords and whose jaws are set with knives to devour the poor from the earth, the needy from among the human race. ... **17** The eye that mocks a father, that scorns obedience to a mother, will be pecked out by the ravens of the valley, will be eaten by the vultures.
