The key issue: the authority of prophecy (Deuteronomy 18:11-20; Numbers 11:24-30; Ephesians 2:20; 3:4-6; 4:11-13; 1 Cor.14:37-38)	
Prophecy (Capital "P")	
prophecy (small "p")	
(Compare Apostle ["A"] vs. apostle ["a"])	
The purpose of New Testament prophecy (1 John 4:1-3; 2 John 7-11; 1 Corinthians 12:3-7; 14:4-26; Hebrews 2:4; Revelation 19:10)	

A tentative definition of prophecy today:

Prophecy is a particular gift from God to speak truth about the gospel in love, to build up the church, sometimes with miraculous specificity.

How should the church handle prophecy?

The church can easily overreact in two ways:

- 1. Hyper-charismatic
- 2. Sub-charismatic
