

How can I hear God speak? (PART 1)



Think of an effective speaker (politician / celebrity / actor / etc) - what is it that makes them effective?

God has spoken

God is light (1 John 1:5; Jn.1:4-9; 3:15-21; 8:12-18; 9:39; 2 Pet.1:19)

"Just as it is the nature of light to shine, so it is the nature of God to reveal himself." (John Stott, I Believe in Preaching)

God has acted (Ps.19:1; Isa.6:3; Rom.1:19-20; 1 John 4:10)

... in creation

... in redemption


God has spoken

By his speech, God ACTS (Gen.1; Mk.4:39; Jn.11:43)

By his speech, God RELATES (Gen.3; Gen.12)

"God has so identified with his words that whatever someone does to God's word (whether it is to obey or to disobey) they do directly to God himself." (Timothy Ward, Words of Life)

By his speech, God EXPLAINS (Abraham / Moses / Israel / Jesus)



2 Timothy 3:15-16; Hebrews 1:1-3


"God put his Word into human minds and human mouths in such a way that the thoughts they conceived and the words they spoke were simultaneously and completely theirs as well as his." (John Stott, I Believe in Preaching)

What about now?

God speaks	through what he said in the

"It is written" = "it/he says"

- * Galatians 4:21-22, 27, 30
- * Hebrews 1:6; 2:12; 3:7; cf. 4:12; 12:5
- 1 Samuel 3:21!



"The Bible is God preaching." (Jim Packer)

So, let's read our Bibles!

* IT'S CLEAR

2 Corinthians 4:3-6

- God truly communicates through Scripture (2 Cor.4:3-6)
- All that we need for salvation is crystal clear (2 Tim.3:15)
- Problem is our hearing (2 Cor.4:6; Lk.8:18; Matt.11:25-26)
- Doesn't mean everything is easy to understand (2 Pet.3:16; 2 Tim.2:7)

* IT'S SUPREMELY AUTHORITATIVE

- It's GOD revealing himself! (1 Sam.3:21)
- So pay attention! (Heb.2:1; Jas.1:19-22)
 - [Yes, this is a circular argument...]

* IT'S SUFFICIENT

2 Peter 1:3-21

- All we need for life & godliness (2 Pet.1:3-4)
- Keep remembering it (2 Pet.1:12-15; cf. 2 Tim.3:14;4:2)
- Mustn't add / subtract (Rev.22:18-19)
