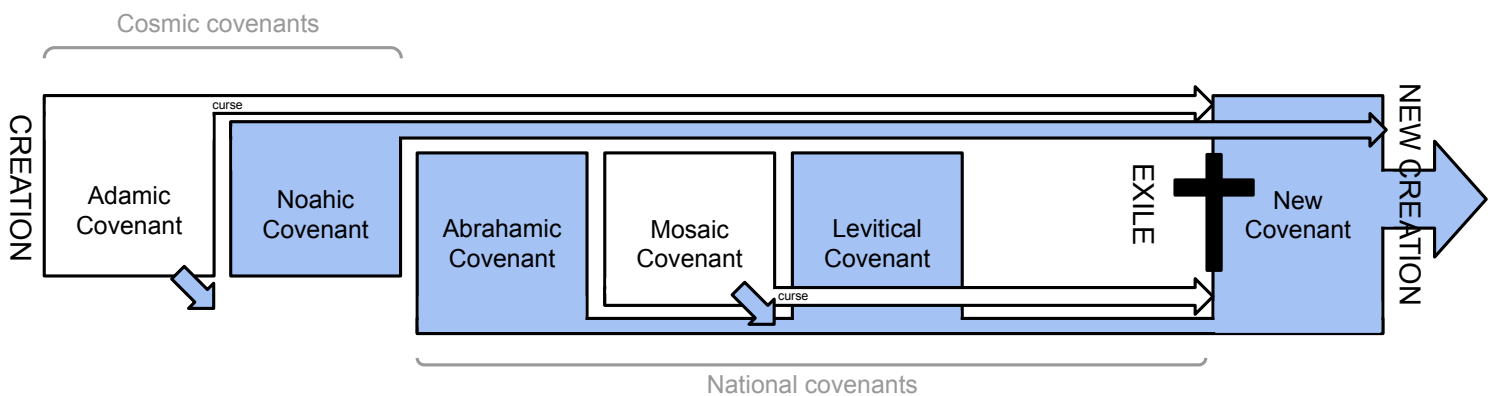
1) Life at war

• Still under Mosaic covenant (Joshua 23-24)



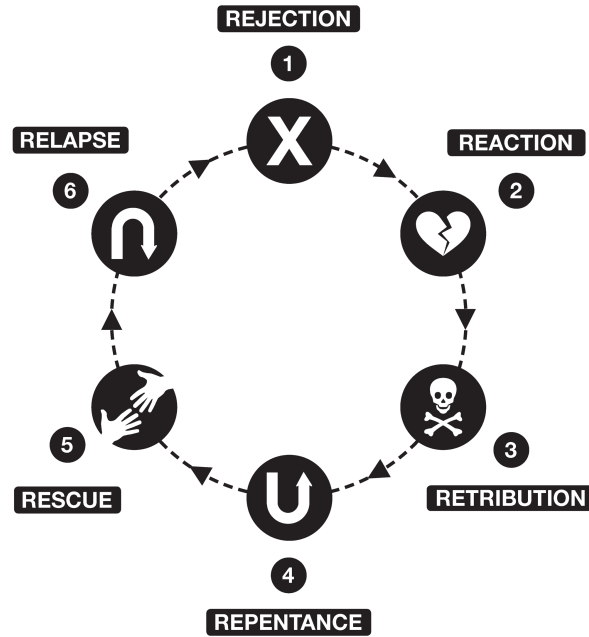
'Suzerain-vassal' type covenants

- A king like the nations

(1 Samuel 8-9)

- A king after God's own heart

(1 Samuel 16)

- God's king prevails!

(2 Samuel 5-6)

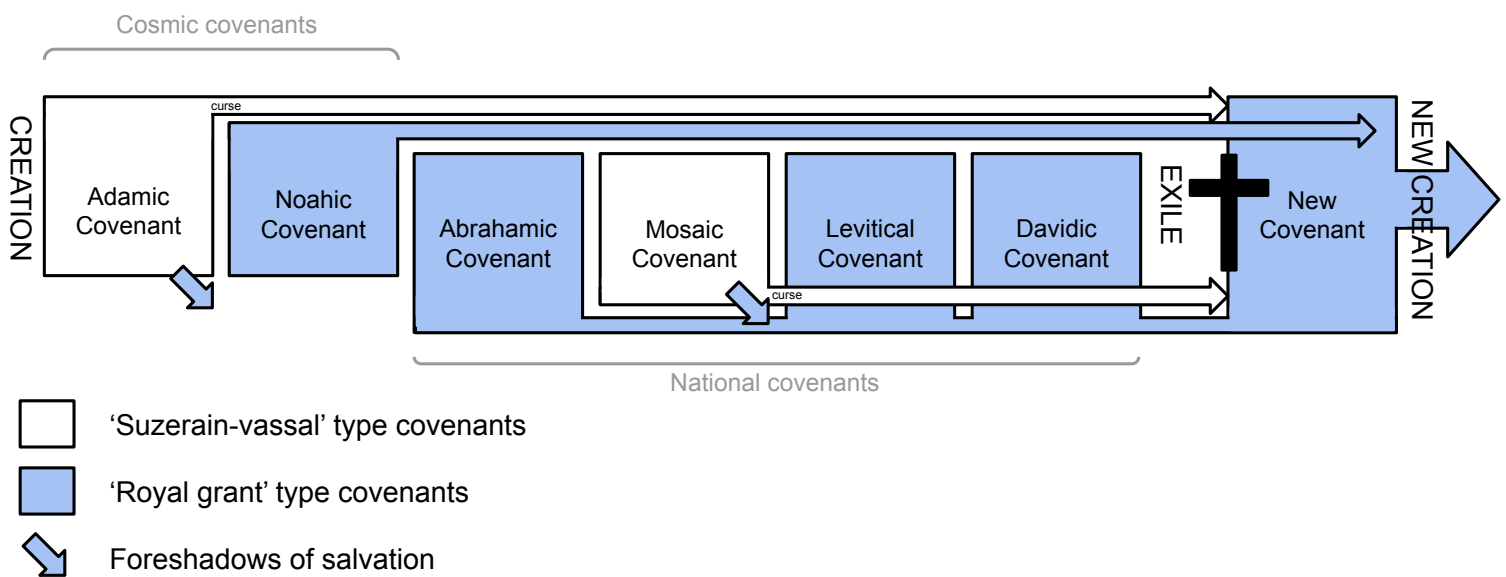
God's People	God's Place	God's Presence

- ▶ 'On' by grace for his offspring
